## 2006 PREDICTIONS

*The Universe shifts and alters events to suit its own purpose. We do not pretend to be privy to the inner workings of the Divine Forces.*

In December 2005, we asked our ministers to sit in meditation and channel predictions from Spirit on events taking place in 2006 (weather patterns, politics, international events, war and peace, and worldwide spiritual development).

Eight NSSC ministers responded, presenting a fascinating glimpse into the major possibilities and probabilities for 2006 for a variety of topics and situations around the globe. Grouped into 14 categories, their predictions were presented on New Year's Day, January 1<sup>st</sup> at the first

Sunday service of 2006.

We are now six months into the year, so it seemed a good time to revisit these predictions.

Note: Each symbol (>) highlights a different minister's predictions under that particular topic.

### General:

> Humanity begins to "wake up" spiritually, as the call / pull from our souls cut through former apathy. This becomes a force for good that positively affects the war in Iraq, terrorist tensions, and politics.

> No major changes in 2006. It seems a year of settling some of the problems of 2005, and a time of preparation for the challenges of 2007. Positive thinking and action will be needed by everyone.

### Medicine / Health:

> A color-cube cure for Cancer.

> Advancements in health that are pleasing for the world. There will be an advancement which will elevate some fears of a pandemic for us and abroad.

> Definite advancements in widespread use of acupuncture and aromatherapy that are recognized by the AMA. More of these and other alternative medical treatments including therapeutic massage will be recognized and paid for by insurance companies.

> AIDS - 15 year forecast: The cure for AIDS will be made publicly known within the next 15 years, if not sooner. However, the AIDS epidemic will continue to spread quicker than formerly imagined, causing the cure to be found and disclosed even sooner. The cure will be made known after millions of Africans (Continued on p. 2)

are annihilated.

**2006 Weather:**

➤ June 14 - A Krakatowa type event in area of Venezuela.

(August 1883, in Indonesia, was the site of the major volcanic explosion of the island of Krakatowa. Shock waves, measured by barograph, traveled around the earth seven times and giant tsunami waves were triggered, killing over 30,000 people.)

In August, - we will see an earthquake in India.

November - slippery, first snow.

➤ Shifting of the Earth results in further natural disasters. Part of the problem is that man has not learned to work peacefully with nature, therefore creating the natural effects we're now experiencing in the world.

Those who know the power of thought and energy can not sit back and merely look the other way, hoping someone else will speak up. We have our part to do – speaking out, standing up and participating in a global change. As we are the ones creating havoc, we are the ones to fix it! How? By changing our beliefs about life.

➤ Winter in 2006 will be cooler than usual. Summer hurricanes will not be as strong as 2005 and not as destructive to the area, including the Caribbean and

Bahamas. The number of hurricanes will still be higher than the last ten years, but **not causing as much major damage in 2006** as in 2005. Hear the number four (4), maybe four major ones.

**Animals:**

➤ More discovery of beached dolphins and whales because they have consciously chosen to leave the earth plane.

➤ Further scientific research into telepathic communication between dogs, cat and humans is written about. Pet owners are taught to “talk” with their animals through mental pictures.

**War in Iraq:**

➤ The war will continue with political badgering back and forth and the status quo remains the same. However, toward the end of the year there will be a glimmer of light for Iraq in getting along with others and defending themselves.

➤ September – U.S. troops begin to return by September 19<sup>th</sup>. And in October, more troops come marching home.

➤ President Bush continues to loose popularity and begins process of returning troops under heavy political pressure.

**Terrorism:**

➤ Terrorism will continue at the pace it is now, which is a struggle for the whole world. Do not feel major or substantial changes. Two news worthy terrorist hits next year (2007), one in an Asian/Middle East country, the other in a European county, France? Spain?

U.S. averts major hits again, but this situation must be dealt with on a world wide level by opening dialogue and bringing the whole world into discussions as this situation will continue to escalate in 2007 if advancement is not made in 2006.

Around Spring a major shift takes place within the terrorist organization, possibly the death of a major player – this becomes a ripe time for advancement toward peace.

**Individuals:**

➤ More “group deaths,” especially among families. (... usually happens by agreement on the soul level to leave together in “accidents” in planes, train.

➤ More deaths in 2006 than in any other previous year, not from crime, but because souls are tired, feel they have completed their “work” and are ready to leave.

Note: take time this year to get your “affairs” in order. Take time to talk with loved ones, and do things for yourselves that you enjoy!

**2006 International Issues:**

➤ February/March — In the world market, money swells / levels by end of March

April - major offensive in China, doors close, agreements in limbo. Cambodia is an issue.

By August 17 conflict in Middle East will come to a head and begin to recede.

December - nothing is settled, the world is up in arms again. Also, Israel-Arab conflict continues.

➤ In the greater world, a full accounting will be demanded of power abusers, who will be required to cease, desist and make full restitution for the harm they have done.

**2006 - US and US Economy:**

➤ July - Fire month – row houses burn making way for new construction.

➤ The media continues to amplify fears over lack of money in our economy.

➤ The US economy does not see much change; slight increases and decreases here and there but the (Continued p. 4)

**Law of Polarity**

basic economy stays the same with a little less growth overall in 2006. But we must prepare for the following year as some changes will occur in 2007.

**Challenges for humanity:**

**The African  
Continent:  
A 5-15 Year Forecast:**

The following five to fifteen year forecast for the African continent was one of the channeled predictions received by one of our ministers:

**Changes in population**

In 2006, the continent of Africa continues to be exploited. The AIDS pandemic / genocide continuation is not by chance. As more African natives die, the face of Africa will change. Well over more than 50% of Africa's people are affected with AIDS and at least 70% of those infected will die within the next five years. And there will be a **migration of people coming into Africa of Asiatic decent.**

**Industrial Development**

The main cause of exploitation in Africa will not be for diamonds and gold as in the past. This new **exploitation will be for real estate as well as for oil.** African real estate will house industries from China, Europe, Arabia, and the United States.

The countries of the Cameroons and the Congo in Central Africa will be affected the most.

Media reports of townships being heavily affected with AIDS only serves as a “curtain” for industrial development already begun in the central regions of Africa. Monies sent to Africa are being used for medicines, for the development of technological industries and for refineries.

**Real estate will be coveted more than oil** as time goes on. Plans have already been drawn without proper or legal representation from the people and governments of Central Africa. Land is plowed down, and people are no longer told to leave the land, they are just left to die. Their lack of experience and knowledge in these areas leaves them open to exploitation.

Rain Forrest areas and rich green land will be destroyed and cultivated for the sake of “progress.” (Cont. p.5)

### Bargaining Chips

Native peoples will be seen as annoyances, and will be exploited openly for cheap labor. Bargaining chips for their cheap labor and services will revolve around AIDS and HIV medicines, food, water, and for the very lucky, education and health benefits.

Once again, African natives will be slaves in their own land. To other nations around the globe, this slavery will be covert, but is there for those who have eyes to see.

### A New Leader on the Horizon

However, the Phoenix will rise out of the ashes of Central Africa and people of all hues will be united. After many have died from AIDS, diseases and revolution, a female leader will appear to lead the people of the African continent with compassion and empathy. She does not travel with an entourage and will be vaguely in the media's eye. This is her best defense and asset.

She is a woman of the people, dark skinned and of Asiatic decent who blends in. She looks to be East Indian, is round and very confident. Educated in the West, and able to motivate the masses, she is wise, and non-confrontational and is comforter of others. Not a politician, but very aware of public policy, she will teach men and women to do things for themselves in order to feed and support themselves.

She is well versed in economics, politics, public policy and religion. A woman whose "burden is light." Many will come to listen to and see her.

This is her time. She has come to guide the chariot of peace and order. Her mission will be strongest in Central Africa and she will migrate towards East Africa to continue her work.

has been cultivated in Central Africa. She will be revered because she will act with love and courage. She is not a woman to stay in the traditional place of women, she never has had to, because her being is of love and courage.

After her coming, peace will reign in this area for many, many years, but first, there will be a time of great repression, loss of life, exploitation, and manipulation before she emerges. The phoenix not only represents her, it represents a new nation. Central Africa will be the home of this new order. This time of peace is specifically for her to govern.

### NSSC Outreach Committee Expansion

#### Who speaks for you?

Who has the **legal authority** to speak for you to doctors if you are unable to speak for yourself?

- Is someone aware of your wishes if you were incapacitated for a period of time or not expected to live?
- If you were suddenly taken to the hospital tomorrow, who in your family or among your friends would know your doctor's name and phone number, details of your physical condition, and any allergies to medications you may have?

If you died today, who in your family would know where your Will is kept? Do you have a Will?

- Who would know where to find insurance papers, or what to do to arrange for your burial and

funeral?

- Do you have money set aside to cover burial costs?
- Will there be any money left over to defer expenses and debts?
- Where is your burial plot or have you made arrangements to be cremated?

### Funeral Arrangements

Have you thought realistically about your funeral?

- Does your family know or have accurate information for your obituary?
- Who will conduct your service?
- What favorite verses from scripture, poetry, essays or songs do you desire included in the service that will provide comfort to your family?

These are questions for which many people have no answers; yet they should, in order to spare their loved ones further doubt and confusion!

### No cost financial review

As chairman of the NSSC Outreach Committee and in keeping with the broader spirit of the committee, as envisioned by the Board of Directors, **Rev. George Quillet** brings his expertise in personal finance planning to help members of our spiritual community answer these and **many** other questions. In a no-cost personal financial planning and review session with Rev. George, expect to be asked probing and thought-provoking questions that will spur you into action and help bring your personal and financial affairs in order.

Rev. George will initially meet with interested persons at places and times of their convenience. As the project grows, he will set up a central point and times for appointments.

### Don't Wait Until Too Late

Many families find out too late the importance of stating preferences for where money, and assets should go. This is important for individuals and their families to discuss and make decisions, because otherwise, the State may make the determination for you.

Pay attention to areas such as guardianship for children, a caretaker for pets, an Advance Medical Directive, Long Term Care insurance (if applicable), an Advocate who would speak for you should you be laid up for a long time, and money set aside for funeral expenses.

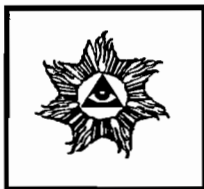
